ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA

To be eligible for any of our traineeship, you must comply with all of the following conditions:

- Nationality: You must be a national of one of the EUROCONTROL or ECAC Member States;
- Education: You are currently studying for a post-secondary educational qualification (Bachelor's, Master's or PhD level). If you have graduated, the traineeship must start within one year after your date of graduation.
- Language skills: Our working languages are English and French. To do a traineeship, you will need to have a good command of English (both written and verbal). Knowledge of French is a great asset, but not always a must.
- No previous traineeships longer than 6 months at EUROCONTROL: Individuals with
 previous traineeships at EUROCONTROL lasting less than 6 months are eligible to apply.
 If you have completed a traineeship for less than 6 months previously, you may still
 undertake a second traineeship for up to a total duration of 12 months, including the
 previous traineeship.

- The selection and interview phase will take place in June and July.
- All candidates will be informed of the outcome by late August, regardless of the result.
